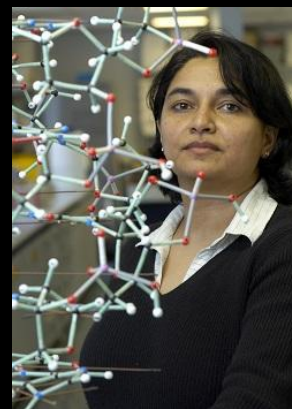

About the Speaker

Dr Momna Hejmadi is a Senior Teaching Fellow in the Department of Biology and Biochemistry. A PhD in radiation oncology, she is actively involved in research in tumor hypoxia. Besides research she has established an impressive record of enhancing student learning in biosciences. During her teaching career in India, US and UK, Dr. Hejmadi has introduced peer assessments, built new approaches to undergraduate research projects, standardized enquiry-led introductory courses for laboratory practicals, enhanced large-group lecturing, and led on cross-cultural curriculum development. Recently she led the first massive online learning course (MOOC) from Bath, known as “Inside Cancer”, with over 32000 diverse learners from more than 90 countries.

Being the Director of Studies at the University of Bath, Dr. Momna has also established international master’s level programs and has led exploration of cross-cultural pedagogies. Using UK India Education and Research Initiative (UKIERI) funding she set up an innovative program, part taught in India and the UK, with an international curriculum. The program has exceptional advantages for students (research experience in academia and industry), and staff (enhancement of practice and program, level changes).
